Empowering Authors

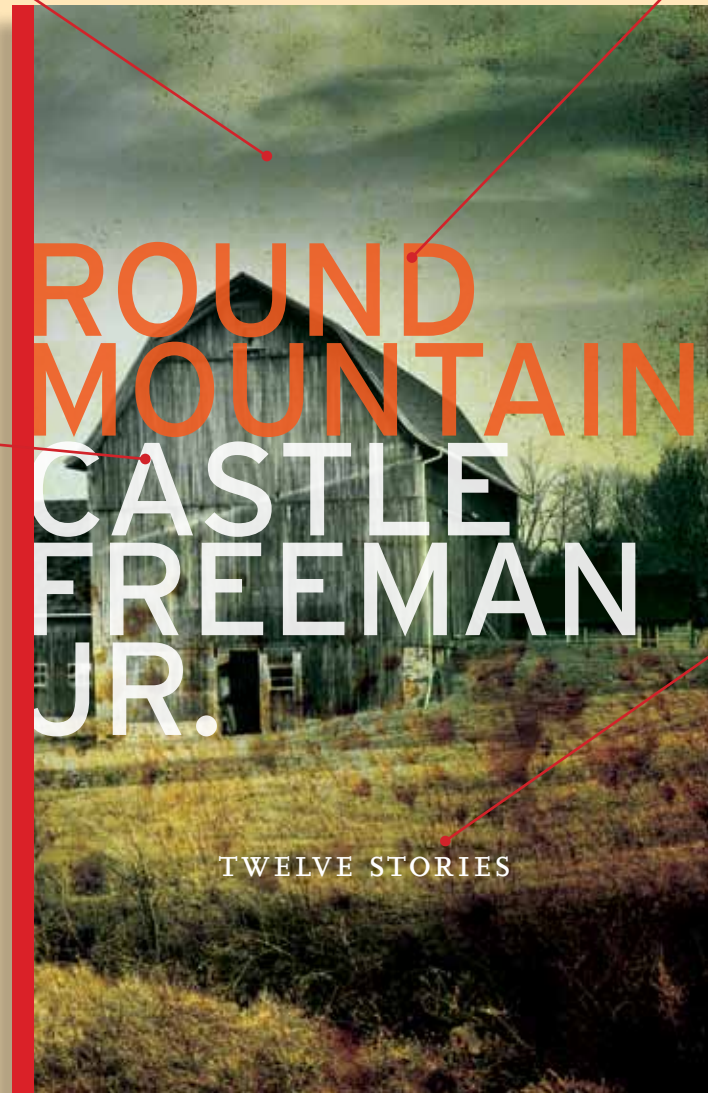
